The National Association of Brass Band Conductors (NABBC) was founded in 1946 with the intention of promoting the interest of its members by providing an effective organisation through which conferences, workshops and other activities could be arranged. Thus, by lectures, discussions and demonstrations, the musical progress of its members could be fostered.

Today, the association is still endeavouring to pursue these aims. Nationally, there is an annual convention weekend which incorporates the AGM and in the regional areas, meetings with guest speakers and workshops give fellowship with other conductors at the same time as providing help and instruction.

The NABBC maintains a score lending library, some of which have hand written notes from old masters with the baton. In addition the NABBC publishes a quarterly magazine, '*The Conductor*', which is sent to all members and contains articles and information of help to all conductors.

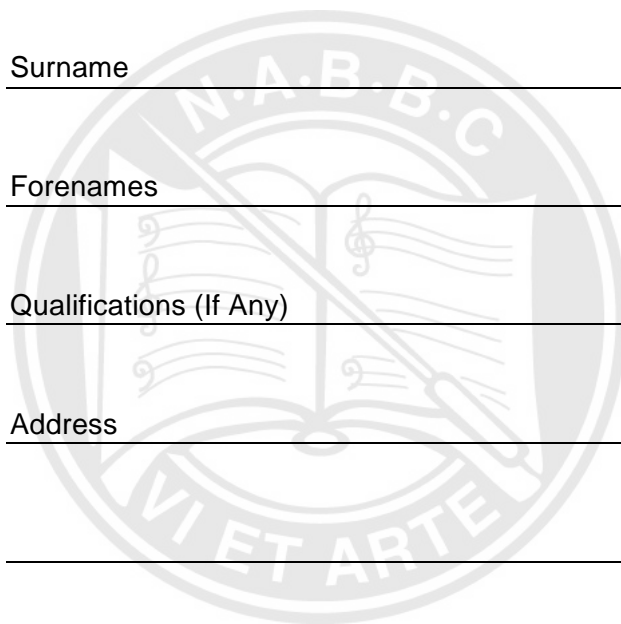
